# Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CC&R), By-Laws and City Code Reminders..



City of Enumclaw Code 19.44.015 Occupied lots - Mowing required.

All occupied properties shall be kept mowed such that the height of the grass and vegetation shall not exceed 12 inches, except for cultivated trees and shrubs.

## Parking (CC&R Sec. 7.15) and Enumclaw Municipal Code control parking restrictions (whichever is more restrictive.)

- No RV's, Boats, Campers, Motorcycles, Trailers, etc. etc., allowed to be parked or stored on any Lot for a cumulative period in excess of fourteen days in any one calander year.
- No Parking "Against" the flow of Traffic.
- No Parking on The City Sewer Lift Station Property
- No Parking within five feet of a driveway -or- painted yellow curbing

# Plan on painting or alterations to your house?

Exterior building alterations (including painting) must have prior written approval by the HOA Board.

## Parking Strips Maintenance

Each owner is responsible for maintaining the landscaping on their lots including the planting strips located adjacent to their lot.
