Generally, CC&R's are meant to preserve the integrity of the neighborhood, keep property values high, and allow for the enjoyment of the community.

#### Prepare Your Home For Winter Tips

Take a moment to consider how to prepare your home for winter. Don't be tempted to overlook preparing for the season. Simple things, like routine maintenance of your heating system, can save you unexpected and expensive repairs in the middle of a cold snap or heavy rains.

- \*Drain your lawn-irrigation system to save sprinklers.
- \*Turn off exterior faucets to prevent pipes from freezing
- \*Check your roof for any loose or missing shingles.
- \*Clean your gutters and inspect the downspouts.
- \*Reverse your ceiling fans for more energy savings.

called varnishing. The carburetor and other engine parts gunk up, making the motor difficult to start in the spring. Look for drafts around your home. Gaps around windows, doors, cracks in your foundation and spots where cables or pipes enter are prime culprits for letting cold air in.

# Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CC&R), By-Laws and City Code Reminders...



Parking (CC&R Sec. 7.15) and Enumclaw Municipal Code control parking restrictions (whichever is more restrictive.)

- No RV's, Boats, Campers, Motorcycles, Trailers, etc. etc., allowed to be parked or stored on any Lot for a cumulative period in excess of fourteen days in any one calander year.
- No Parking "Against" the flow of Traffic.
- No Parking on The City Sewer Lift Station Property
- No Parking within five feet of a driveway -or- painted yellow curbing

#### Celebrate the Holidays and share this pie! Grandma's Pumpkin Pie Receipe

2 Eggs

1 Can of Pumpkin

3/4 Cup of Sugar

1/2 Teaspoon Salt

1 2/3 Cup of evaporated milk

1 Teaspoon ground ginger

1 Teaspoon cinnamon

1/4 Teaspoon ground cloves

1/4 Teaspoon ground nutmeg

Mix all ingredients together and place in unbaked pie shell. Bake at 425 degrees for 15 minutes then reduce heat to 350 degrees and continue baking for 45 minutes. Remove from the oven and allow to cool before serving.

\*Tip - The last 15 minutes of cooking is key to the success. Poke a toothpick in the center and remove from heat when the toothpick comes out clean.
